Application Priority Dates

For fall semester or full year: March 1

For spring semester: November 1

Failure to apply by the stated deadlines could delay the processing of visa documents necessary to make your travel arrangements. It is not possible to begin the semester after the first day of classes.

How to Apply

The home university should provide the Assistant Dean for International Programs with the name and contact information of the LLM nominee by March 1 (Fall enrollment) or November 1 (Spring enrollment). Nominees should then complete the Indiana University online electronic application, or [eApp](#).

Proof of Funding

All US universities are required to collect proof of funding information for international applicants. This documentation is required for visa documents and visa interview. *Delay in sending proof of funding = delay in getting visa*
